

## Travelling to Cyfas

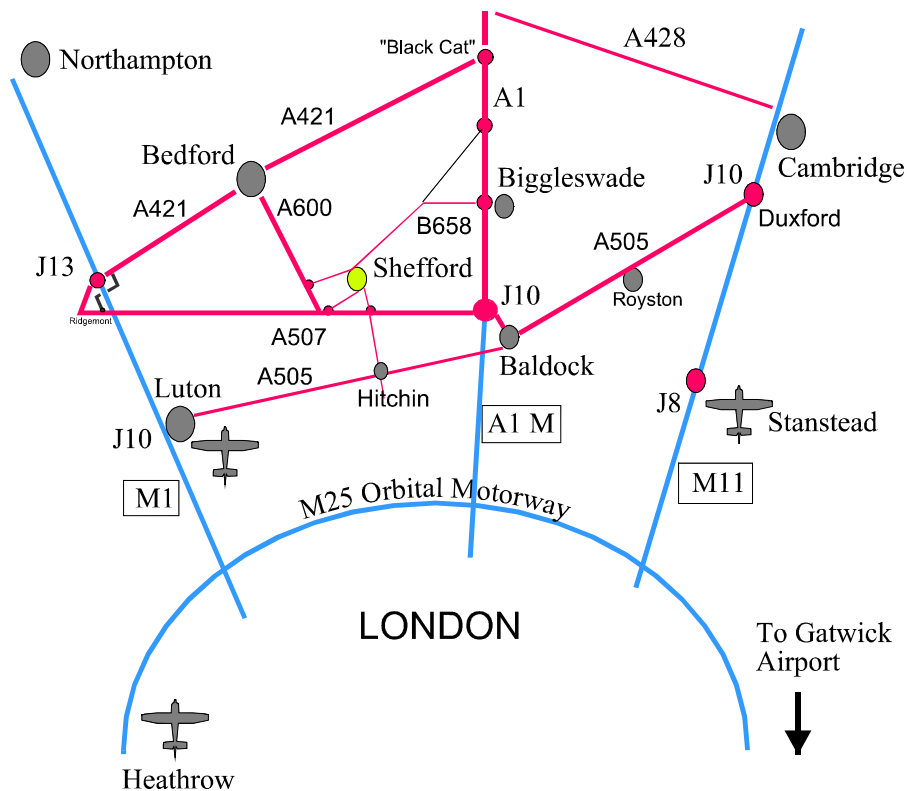

## General Location

We are in Mid Bedfordshire about 40 miles North of London, this is generalised map of the region:-



## By Road

### From M1 North & South

Leave the M1 at Junction 13 and turn towards Bedford. Immediately after leaving the junction turn right at the traffic lights to take a B road towards Ridgemont. This is a short cut which turns back under the M1 to pick up the A507, the MI – AI link road. Turn left onto the A507 and follow East signed to Ampthill and Shefford. At Shefford go straight over the roundabout on the by-pass and

into the town centre. In about 1 mile, at the traffic lights, turn right into South Bridge Street and in 200 yards take the first right into Ivel Road (next to the Fire Station). We are through the second set of gates on the left down a short drive. Visitor parking in the spaces nearest to reception or next to the reception wall if busy.

### **From A1 South**

Travel up the A1M to the Beds & Herts border and the end of the Motorway, Junction 10. Leave the A1M via the slip road and at the roundabout (under the A1) turn left onto the A507 (West). Follow the A507 West bound (A1 – M1 link road) and go straight over roundabouts at Stotfold and Henlow village (cross the A6001) towards Shefford. At the next roundabout signposted left as “Henlow Camp” where there is a Hotel, go straight over. At the next roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> right (near Petrol station) towards Shefford. This is Ivel road, we are towards the far end on the right hand side. We are through a set of gates on the left down a short driveway. Visitor parking is the spaces nearest to reception or next to the reception wall if busy.

### **From A1 North**

Travel South to Biggleswade in Bedfordshire which is about 8 miles South of the A1 –A428 (Bedford) “Black Cat” Junction. Beware of speed cameras as you go past Sandy ! At Biggleswade “Sainsbury’s” roundabout turn right (East) on the B658 toward Old Warden & Shefford. In about 1.5 mile turn left (South) at the “G&M Growers” round-about onto the B659. Stay on this road until you reach Shefford. At the mini roundabout turn left into North Bridge Street and into the town centre. Go straight over the lights into South Bridge Street and in 200 yards take the first right into Ivel Road (next to the Fire Station). We are through the second set of gates on the left down a short driveway. Visitor parking in spaces nearest to reception or next to the reception wall if busy.

### **By Rail**

There is no direct rail link with Shefford. The nearest main line stations are:-

**From London, Kings Cross**, take Great Northern Line to Hitchin – then 8 miles by road / Taxi Via A600 to Henlow then Shefford, Alternatively to Biggleswade, also 8 miles by Taxi.

**From Peterborough and the North** – Great Northern Line – to Biggleswade – then 8 miles by road Taxi. Follow directions as for A1 South from Biggleswade Sainsbury roundabout

**From the North West or London St Pancras**, Bedford station is within 10 miles of Cyfas, take A600 direct to Shefford.

### **From Luton Airport ~ 12 Miles by Road**

Take A505 towards Hitchin, then the A600 towards Bedford, At Henlow Camp, follow signs to Clifton and Shefford

### **From Heathrow Airport ~ 65 Miles by Road**

There is a London Underground rail link to London Kings Cross main line station. Then see travelling by rail above. Otherwise via M25 London Orbital Motorway North bound (Clock wise) to the M1 or A1. Then follow directions above (A1M route less busy)

### **From Gatwick Airport – ~ 110 Miles by Road**

There is a direct rail link to Bedford (Gatwick Express) or to London Kings Cross –see travel by rail above. Otherwise via M25 London Orbital Motorway East bound (anti-clockwise) to the M11 or A1M. Then follow directions above.

## **From Stanstead Airport ~ 50 Miles by Road**

There is a direct rail link to London but not to Bedfordshire.

By road take the M11 North to J10 (Duxford). Leave the Motorway up the slip road and turn left past the Duxford Museum onto the A505. Follow A505 West past Royston and to Baldock. At Baldock traffic lights turn right onto the A507. In about 2 miles Pass under the A1M at Junction 10 and stay on the A507. Follow instructions as for A1 South above.
